ABOUT ABBA VINEYARDS LOUIS SYRAH

Abba Vineyard's outstanding winegrape quality has evolved over time, from generation to generation, starting in 1932 when Louis Abba, Sr. purchased the property and began farming winegrapes. Louis Abba, Jr. (pictured above on the left) is now steward of the vineyard along with his son, Phil Abba. Warm days, cool nights, alluvial soils, a modified VSP trellis system, and premium viticultural practices create a Syrah worthy of distinction.

Approximately 50 tons available for the 2023 vintage. Open to selling as small lots or one single lot.

We can assist with all aspects of the harvest from the field to the winery, with all harvesting done at night with our own capable crews.
